Winters Heritage House's log structures were saved from demolition in the late 1980s. The museum is a volunteer-run educational non-profit. We rely largely on membership support to maintain the buildings and programming.

Winters Heritage House serves these purposes in our community;

We preserve two of Elizabethtown's original log structures from two different immigrating cultures.

Note first hand the architectural differences between our Scotch-Irish Log house and our Pennsylvania German log house. Now connected, but originally separate, these houses were built with the same available technologies! (c. 1760)

We support groups that practice traditional skills such as quilting, hand-spinning, hearth cooking, herb gardening, and a host of local artists. Committees are very open to new members!

We provide Elizabethtown students with history-based educational programs such as the Bev Ulrich Third Grade Walking Tours and a monthly pre-school story hour.

We offer exhibits that give insights to our community's history through our May Antique Quilt exhibit, our annual historic photos of Elizabethtown exhibit, and other spontaneous displays.



We provide the community with a library full of images and records on Elizabethtown's history. You can research the history of specific people, buildings, organizations, schools, events, and more, going back to the founding of the town.

Visit the Seibert Genealogy Library to get a quick glimpse of our resources.

We have a rentable community space that helps support museum activities.
